

INCREDIBALL CRICKET

RULES

The game is played with a normal cricket bat (wood) and an incrediball ball.

Each team has eight players and bats for sixteen overs.

The team is divided into four pairs with each pair batting for four overs each.

You start with 200 runs

Every member of the fielding side has to bowl at least one over each (overarm) but no more than three. The wicket keeper does not have to bowl.

Every time the batter gets out, five runs come off the total and the batters swap places.

But you can score runs exactly the same as in normal cricket to increase your total.

You can get out by being bowled, caught, LBW, stumped, run out or if you hit your own wicket.

If a wide or a no-ball is bowled then the batting side get an extra two runs - but no additional ball is bowled. (except in the last over)

And you're not allowed any fielder within 10 yards of the batsman - except the wicketkeeper.
